

Power Packs Program

- 83 families are currently enrolled-306 individuals being served weekly
- We are preparing 89 packed bags weekly
- 10 families are utilizing the choice pantry weekly
- Distributing over 700lbs of food per week
- Started deliveries to make food more accessible to families
- New Freezer installed 11/19!
- The Community Garden Harvest has been bountiful this year. Over 1,000lbs of vegetables donated to Power Packs, Senior Housing and the food bank
